INTRODUCTION

The Government Office of Békés County was established by *the Act CXXVI of 2010 on Metropolitan and County-level Government Offices and Legislative Amendments Pertaining to the Establishment of Metropolitan and County-level Government Offices and to Territorial Integration* as a territorial administrative authority of the Hungarian Government with general competences.

The Government Office is directly led by the Administrative Government Commissioner (whose deputy is the Director-General) and consists of three main organizational units:

- Core office (comprising departments like Department of Coordination and Organization, Department of Finances, etc.),
- Sectorial administrative services (for example Labour Centre, Legal Service, etc.)
- District offices, which are directly led by district office managers and subdivide to district core office and district sectorial administrative services. District core offices have Government Windows since January 2011, which are part of a system of integrated public administration customer support offices, that was set up by the Hungarian Government as an important step towards a less bureaucratic public administration.

According to government decisions, the Government Office coordinates and supports the territorial implementation of government functions and it is first or second instance authority in different cases (social cases, child protection, consumer protection, legal supervision of local governments and minority self-governments, etc.). During these procedures, it represents effective, reliable and client-friendly single-window administration, helping the reduction of administrative burdens in Hungary.
